WHO:

The [Conductive Learning Center of North America](#) (CLC) exists to provide opportunities for individuals with motor challenges to achieve optimal physical, cognitive, and social independence through the application and promotion of conductive education principles.

WHAT:

[Conductive Education](#) (CE) is a comprehensive educational rehabilitation approach that emphasizes learning correct physical motions through everyday tasks applied in real-life situations – treating the whole-person, not the disability. CE utilizes peer learning groups in an intensive intellectual environment to promote whole-body wellness and find new ways to accomplish conventional tasks. CE's unique combination of medical knowledge and educational techniques is applied by conductor teachers to help students develop physical, nutritional, social, self-care, and cognitive skills.

WHY:

Individuals with motor disorders face challenges every day to accomplish basic life tasks most of us do without thinking - eating, getting dressed, sitting in a chair, grasping a pencil, socializing with friends. CLC applies the conductive education method to help students "retrain their brain" to perform actions consciously. CLC not only improves the quality of life for students living with a disability, but also directly impacts students' families and decreases reliance on community supports.
